
For Part A, read **each** document carefully and answer the question or questions after each document. Then read the directions for Part B and write your essay.

CONTRIBUTIONS OF THE IRISH

Irish Americans made many important contributions to New York. Irish workers helped build the Erie Canal and the railroads that made New York economically successful. Irish Americans built St. Patrick's Cathedral in New York City. Irish-American politicians, like Robert F. Wagner, Robert F. Kennedy and Daniel P. Moynihan, worked to improve the lives of all New Yorkers. Irish folk music and theater enriched New York's entertainment scene. Some Irish New Yorkers, like James Cagney, became famous movie stars.


